These are a few of our accomplishments from this past year as we set out to celebrate Lake Shore-Severna Park Rotary Club 70th anniversary.

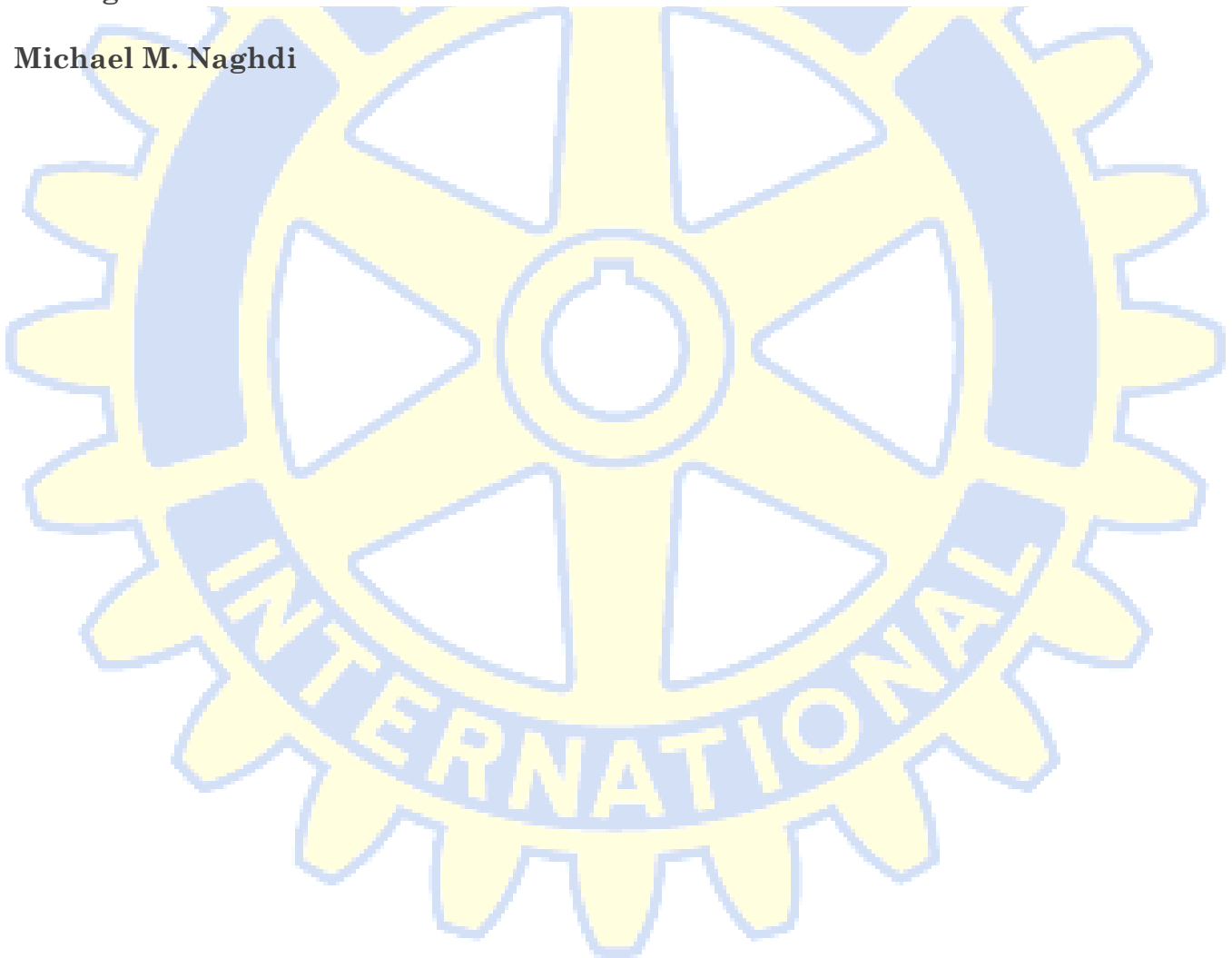
Because of Rotary, I have seen what individuals who are part of a great whole organization can do to better for each other and our world.
